

Call for Unity of Jews and Arabs Against British

JERUSALEM — Recalling the successful united struggle of Arab and Jewish workers in the last year's strike of government employes, the Revolutionary Communist Group, Palestine Section of the Fourth International, has issued a leaflet in Arabic and Hebrew calling for joint action of workers engaged in military camp labor, against mass dismissals and for higher wages.

The leaflet of the Palestine Trotskyists points out that the policy of mass dismissals is pursued by the British in order to sow dissension among the two nationalities and divert them from the struggle for economic demands which has been developing.

The demands raised are for a minimum wage for unskilled labor, a general wage increase to meet rising costs, the recognition of freely elected job committees and control of hiring and firing by the elected job committees.

For effective action against mass dismissals, the leaflet calls for a general strike, condemning "demonstration" strikes of brief duration as ineffective. It winds up with a call for united trade union action and organization.
